

**D**r. David W. Cole is Professor Emeritus of Finance in the Fisher College of Business at The Ohio State University. He holds a bachelors degree from Capital University, a masters degree in business administration from Ohio University, and a doctorate degree in business administration from Indiana University. Professor Cole joined the Ohio State University Faculty of Finance in 1965.

Professor Cole served as Chairman of the Faculty of Finance at Ohio State from 1971 through 1978. He has served as a member of the Governor's Commission on Real Estate Licensing and Education in Ohio, as President of the Midwest Finance Association, as Director of the Eastern Finance Association, and a Vice President of the Financial Management Association. He has been appointed for two terms on The Ohio State University Council on Academic Affairs and for one term on The Ohio State University Council on Admissions and Registration. He has chaired the Search Committee for the John W. Galbreath Chair in Real Estate, the Search Committee for the Everett D. Reese Chair in Banking and Monetary Economics, the College of Business Senate, the College of Business Promotion and Tenure Committee, and the Search Committee for Dean of the College of Business. Dr. Cole was awarded the Pace Setters' Distinguished Service Award by the Fisher College of Business in April, 1994.

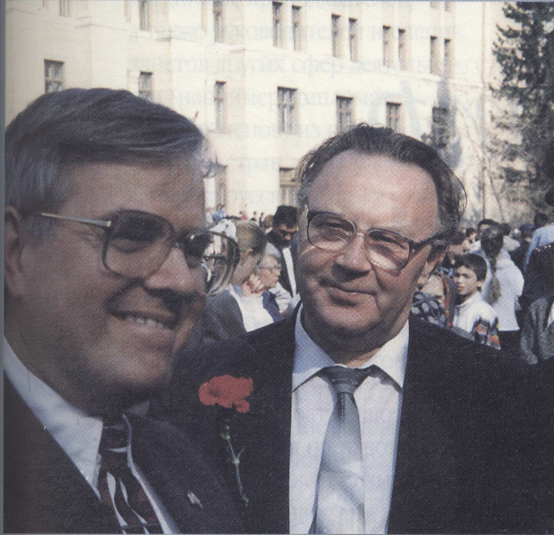
Dr. Cole currently serves as the Chairman of the Fisher College of Business Building Committee. His responsibilities include working with the faculty, staff, and students of the Fisher College, the University Architect's Office, and State of Ohio, and the Associate

Architects in developing and designing a new campus for the Fisher College of Business. During the past three years, he has visited twenty-five colleges and schools of business and executive education, centers to obtain first hand knowledge of the strengths and weaknesses of alternative classroom and office designs and audio-visual delivery systems.

In 1969, Dr. Cole received the Ohio State University Alumni Award for Distinguished Teaching, and in 1975, 1981, 1983, and 1989 received the Outstanding Teaching Award from the College of Business at Ohio State.

Professor Cole was appointed as a founding member of the Academy of Teaching at The Ohio State University in 1993. In April, 1994, he was awarded the Fisher College of Business Distinguished Service Award.

Dr. Cole is an active participant in management education programs. He has served as a faculty member of the Stonier Graduate School of Banking, the business of Banking School, the Graduate School for Savings and Loans, the Commercial Lending School, the Robert Morris Associates Loan Management Seminar, the Loan Policy Roundtable, the National School of Real Estate Finance, the Inter-American Graduate School for Savings and Loans, the Seminar for Presidents, the Executive Seminar, the Asset/Liability Management Seminar for Thrifts, The Financial Planning Seminar for Thrifts, and the Board of Directors Seminar for Thrifts. He currently serves as a faculty member for the Pacific Coast Banking School, the Bank Management Program, and the BAI School. He has published numerous articles and cases relating to the financial management of commercial banks and thrifts

and has worked with over 100 banks and thrifts in analyzing financial strengths and weaknesses, developing financial strategies, and facilitating strategic planning.

In 1992, Dr. Cole inaugurated the Academy for Financial Executives at The Ohio State university. The Academy is an intensive two-year executive education program for members of top management of commercial banks and thrifts. Professor Cole serves as the Academic Director of the Academy.

Professor Cole has traveled to Russia 5 times during the past four years as a representative of The Ohio state University to deliver banking and small business seminars to Russian educators and business leaders. In August, 1994, he was awarded a \$300,000 grant from the United States information Agency for development of business curriculum at three colleges and universities in Tomsk, Siberia, Russia. In June, 1995, he led a delegation of 15 faculty members to Tomsk for 17 days of intensive business curriculum discussions with Tomsk State

University, Tomsk Politechnic University and the Tomsk Academy of Architecture and Engineering. During this visit, he presented a 3 day seminar on «The Business of Banking» to 57 commercial bankers and auditors from the Tomsk Region.

Dr. Cole has served as a board member and advisor for banks, savings and loans, cooperative banks, and investment companies. He served 10 years as a member of the board of directors of Thrinity Lutheran Seminary, 6 years as a member of the board of Lutheran Social Services of Central Ohio, and 1 term as a director of the Upper Arlington, Ohio Rotary Club. He currently serves as 1 of 2 outside trustees of the Upper Arlington Senior Association Fund, Inc., and on the board of trustees of Starr Commonwealth of Albion, Michigan.
