A man with good classic English never gets lost and, if necessary, is easy enough to be able to regroup, get used to another modification of the language. According to domestic experts, it is necessary to start with the British variant because it is the most complete and rich language. American grammar compared to British is markedly simplified. The British version is the more particular. There is a huge set of intonation patterns in it. The Americans, by the way, treat British English with respect. Americans call British English -

the refined language, which they never had, as well as British traditions and culture.

And the most important thing is that classic British is language of a huge number of recognized masterpieces of world art, science, music and history. People around the globe are familiar with the works of Shakespeare, Geoffrey Chaucer, Daniel Defoe, etc. The created immortal works of literature are still the most replicable and loved all over the world. For example, great British scientist, Charles Darwin, whose ideas formed the basis of modern science of biology or talented and influential figure of silent film, Charlie Chaplin, who was named the tenth in the first hundred of the world's greatest film stars.

It is impossible to simplify the English language; simplifying it, we lose the greatest cultural achievements. In conclusion, it is necessary to mention that American English and British English are really just variants of the same English language. They have got more similarities than differences, especially in education or science. The cause of the major discrepancies is the features of the historical and cultural development of the two countries, a variety of local and regional idioms and fixed expressions.
